Licensed, simple, artfully designed node labs situated close to the source of medicines, forging strong partnerships with growers, extracting, assaying, testing, experimenting, listening and being in relation with the sacraments. Initial sites Burundi (mushrooms), Congo (iboga), Gabon (iboga), South Africa (sceletium).

A Cloud Atelier-lab where we partner with elite high end facilities, collaborating with them, gaining access to state-of the-art equipment and resources to analyse, compound, & formulate while offering our unique Ethnomedicine perspectives and phyto-/myco- communications.

Key long-term best in class supply agreements: 1 ton of 12 year plus Iboga under leaf, 2 Ha. Wildcrafted Sceletium (yields of 1 ton+ per annum). A soon to be granted psilocybe mushroom growing licence in the best outdoor growing environment in the world.




